11. The Committee reviewed document CCLM 122/3 *Recommendation 7 of the JIU Report “Review of the state of the investigation function: progress made in the United Nations system organizations in strengthening the investigation function” (JIU/REP/2020/1)*.

12. The Committee was presented with written comments from Australia and Indonesia before the Session. Canada and Venezuela (Bolivarian Republic of) submitted written comments during the Session. Some other Members may transmit written comments after the Session.

13. The Committee welcomed its informal joint working sessions with the Finance Committee and the written contributions submitted by Members. It looked forward to further joint informal working sessions.

14. The Committee looked forward to receiving updated draft procedures at its next Session, revised to take into account inputs received and its deliberations.

15. The Committee took note of developments in other UN Specialized Agencies, encouraged the Secretariat to continue to monitor these developments and recommended that good practices from those Agencies be considered when further developing the procedures.

16. The Committee stressed the importance of concluding the elaboration of appropriate procedures in a timely manner.

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
