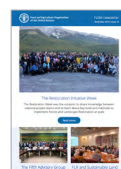

### AGRICULTURE



#### Food loss and waste and food value chains – Teaching guide

This guide is a tool for teachers to use when educating their students about reducing food waste and loss. It promotes best practices through activities and complementary materials, such as quizzes, games and videos.

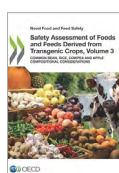
### Main results and metadata by country (2006–2015) – World programme for the census of agriculture 2010

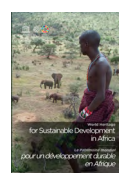


### Safety assessment of foods and feeds derived from transgenic crops, volume 3: Common bean, rice, cowpea and apple compositional considerations
