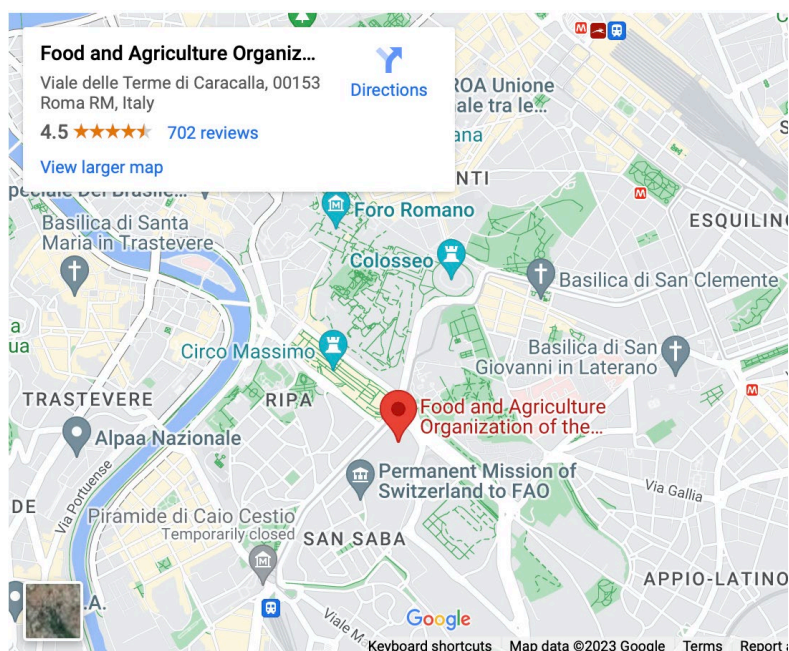

Practical information note

## MEETING VENUE

The FAO Headquarters is located in the city center of Rome, on Viale delle Terme di Caracalla, near the Circo Massimo and close to the Colosseum. It's a lofty white building that is easy to recognize. It can be reached by car, bus, tram and metro line B (*Circo Massimo* stop).

## HOW TO GET TO THE EVENT

### From the airport

- **Taxi: 30 min**

Participants are advised to use only licensed taxis with meters. Surcharge fares are applied for baggage, night runs, Sundays and holidays. Fixed fares (inclusive of all extra charges) are set for journeys to/from airports as follows:

- From Fiumicino Airport to City Centre and vice versa: EUR 48.00
- From Fiumicino Airport to Ciampino Airport and vice versa: EUR 50.00
- From Fiumicino Airport to Tiburtina Station and vice versa: EUR 55.00
- From Fiumicino Airport to Ostiense Station and vice versa: EUR 45.00
- From Ciampino Airport to City Centre and vice versa: EUR 30.00.

Taxi license holders are obliged to issue receipts of payment.

Participants can also call Radio Taxi Service (Tel. 06-3570 or 06-4994). Upon calling, the taxi company operator will ask for the caller's telephone number and will give the caller the taxi's identification number (which will be marked on both sides of the car), as well as the estimated time it will take to reach the caller.

- **Public transport from/to the Airports**

The bus: between 40 min and 1 hour to reach Rome. It can be more because the traffic is often very heavy. The price varies between 6 and 10 euros for a single trip.

Express trains: You can easily reach the center of Rome with the Leonardo Express airport shuttles from Felice Santini train station. The Felice Santini train station is located next to Fiumicino airport so you will have direct access when exiting the plane. The station is very well signposted, you just have to follow the signs.

Leonardo Express trains leave approximately every 15 minutes. The times to reach Rome Termini Station are between 6.40 am and 11.40 pm. The price is 14 euros. From Termini Station it will be easy to reach your accommodation.

## **PUBLIC TRANSPORT IN THE CITY**

### **Buses/Trams**

The public buses in Rome are managed by the *Azienda per i Trasporti Autoferrotranviari del Comune di Roma* (ATAC). Access onto buses/trams is both from the rear and front doors. Tickets should be purchased in advance and immediately validated in one of the machines in the bus or tram. Bus/tram stops can be distinguished by a yellow or green metal post.

### **Underground (Metro)**

There are three underground lines in Rome: Line A, Line B and Line C. The stops are marked by a red and white "M" sign. Line A and Line B intersect at Termini Station, and Line A and Line C intersect at San Giovanni Station. The Metro stop for FAO is Circo Massimo (Line B).

## **ACCOMMODATION**

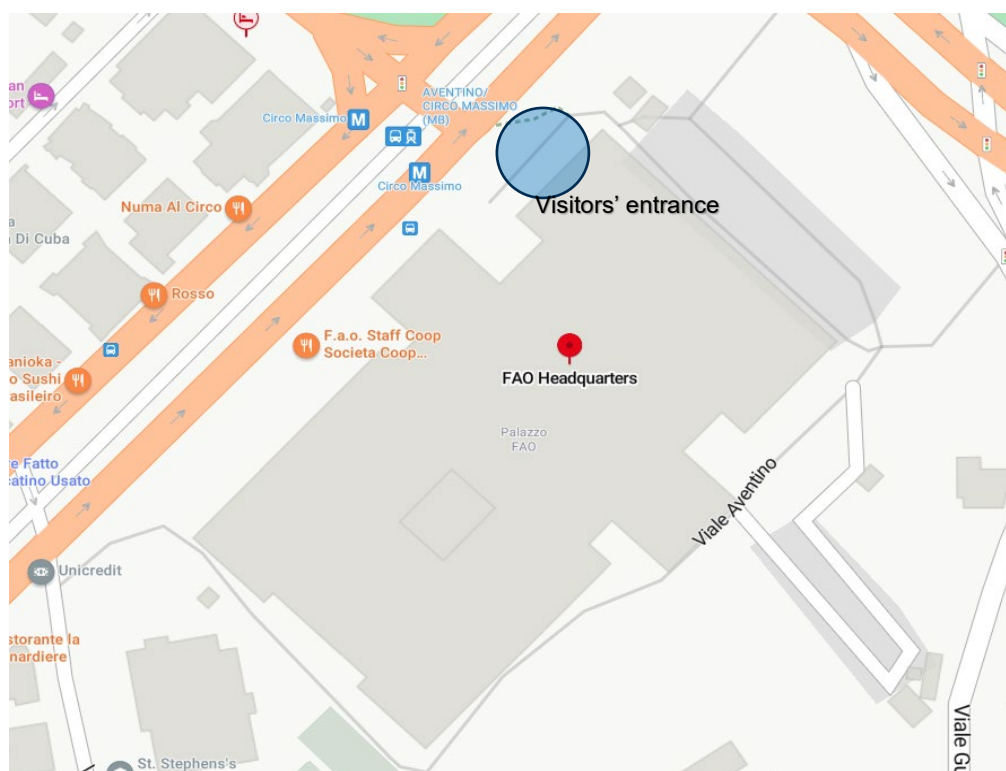

## FAO HEADQUARTERS MEETING ROOMS

- **Venue**

The Inaugural Plenary Assembly of the AMR Multi-Stakeholder Partnership Platform will take place on 15-16 November 2023 at FAO Headquarters, in Rome. Further details are available in the meeting concept note and agenda.



- **Access to the FAO Headquarters**

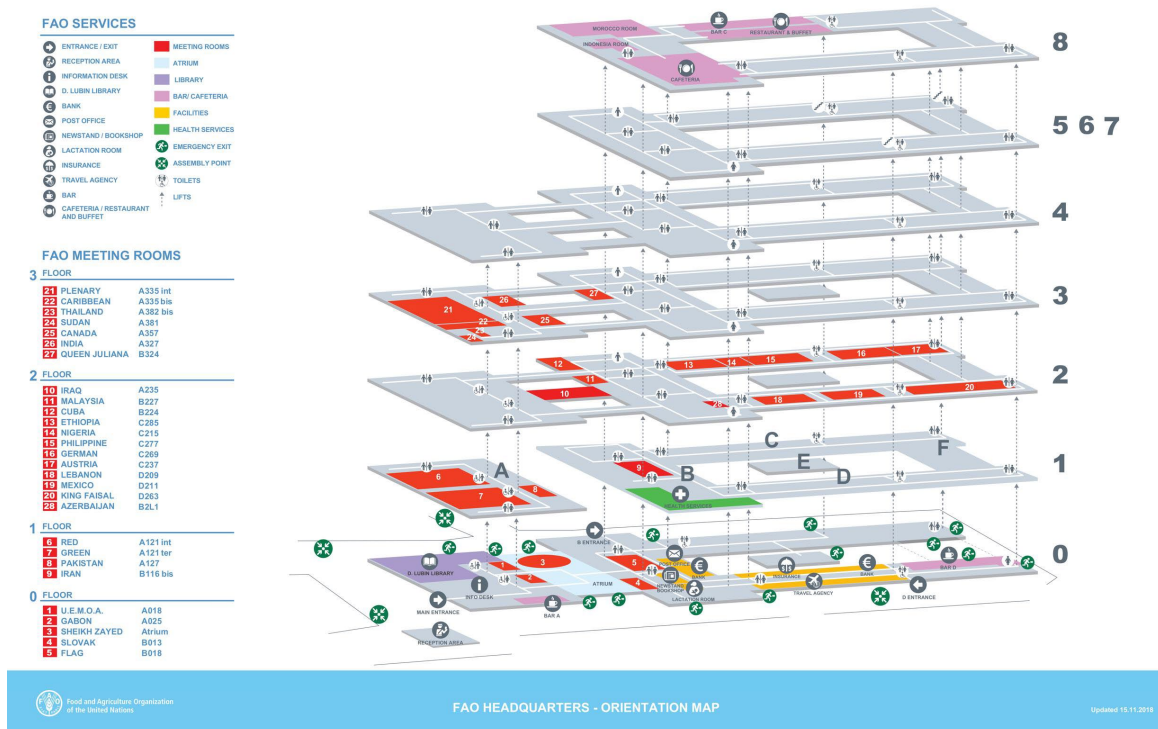
Visitors must enter through the Visitors' entrance located on Viale Aventino (next to Circo Massimo metro station). Access to FAO Headquarters is restricted to persons in possession of a valid building pass (see section on Registration). Participants with meeting badge can enter only through Building A Entrance (Visitor Centre).

**Registration of Participants and Admission to Meetings**

1. On the first day of each meeting, participants are requested to use the Main Entrance in Building A – the Visitor Centre, where metal detectors for security control are in operation, and proceed to the Turkish Registration Centre to the immediate left to register and pick up their Building Pass.
2. Building Passes will be issued only after receipt of completed Registration Forms. A valid identity document will need to be presented to registration officials to collect the Building Pass.
3. Lost Building Passes should be reported without delay to the FAO Security Office.

- **FAO Headquarter buildings**

There are six buildings in FAO Headquarters, all interconnected, and they are identified with letters A-F. The Plenary Assembly meetings will take place in the following meeting rooms: Green Room, Malaysia room, Cuba Room, Queen Juliana room and two small divisional rooms. For more information about the rooms for each of the Plenary panel, please refer to the detailed building map below.



- **Meeting language**

The meeting will be conducted in English with interpretation in six (6) UN languages.

- **Meals**

FAO will provide coffee breaks and lunches during the meeting days in the restaurant on the 8th floor of Building B between 12h30-14h00. A cocktail reception for the participants will be hosted at the Fountain Bar, on the 8<sup>th</sup> floor, on the 15 November between 17h00-19h00.

- **Wi-Fi Coverage**
